



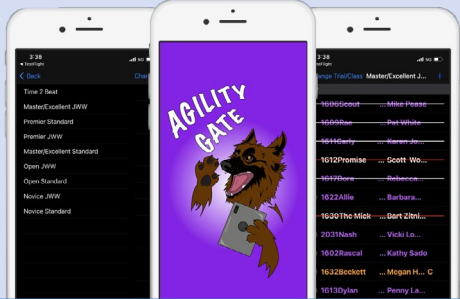

Agility Gate is a free-to-download app that allows competitors to check-in their dogs via their mobile phone or tablet at an agility show and keep track of the current state of the run orders. It helps prevent crowding around the gate and allows competitors to keep tabs on things while crating away from the ring or away from the show site.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site. You can take a picture of the posted maps or download a copy to your phone using the Agility Gate app. Paper copies of the maps will not be available.

Arrival/Setup

There will be no early exhibitor setup on Thursday, December 5 except for volunteers helping to **unload the trailer at 1 PM**. You may set up on Thursday **IF you help unload the trailer**. We can always use help! Thank you!

The building opens at 6:30 AM all three days.

DOGS MAY NOT BE LEFT AT THE SHOW SITE OVERNIGHT.

Measuring

All agility dogs are required to have an Official Jump Height Card, and handlers must be able to present it if asked. Don't forget to bring your height card in case someone asks for it.

Judges **Greg Fontaine** and **Kenneth Boyd** are both **VMO** measuring officials. ALL dogs (regardless of height) without a valid Jump Height Card or Yellow "Temporary Measurement" Form (for dogs under 2 years old) must be measured before their first run of the weekend. Forms will be available at the ribbon-label table. Please fill out a form before asking to be measured. If you already have a permanent height card, be sure to have it with you at the trial in case you are asked for it. If your dog needs to be measured, it is your responsibility to have it done before you run. Failure to do so will result in the removal of any qualifying runs you receive.

Check-In *(Armbands Not Required)*

Pursuant to Chapter 1, Section 19 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, the club will not be requiring the use of armband stickers, so traditional check-in is not required.

No paper check-in will be required. We will be using the **Agility Gate App** for check-in from your phone...see left sidebar for more information.

Running Orders and Course Maps

The run order will be posted on imagilityservices.com 3-4 days prior to the start of the trial.

Course maps will be posted at the trial site per AKC Agility Regulations. Please take a picture of the posted maps for access on your phone or tablet. Maps will also be posted on the Agility Gate App.

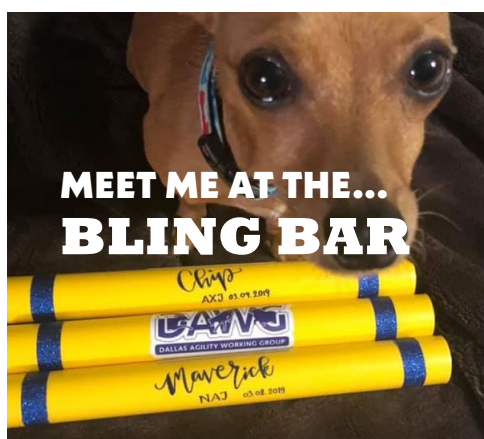
RV PARKING AT MYERS PARK

The Trial Site

The town of McKinney is about 33 miles north of downtown Dallas on U.S. 75/North Central Expressway. From the north or south: On U.S. 75, take the U.S. 380 exit and go west about 2.5 miles to FM1461. Turn right (north) on FM1461 and travel approximately 2.9 miles to County Road 166. Turn right (north) on County Road 166 and go 0.8 (8/10) mile to the site which is on the left. The county has posted directional signs to the Event Center.
